Day #6: Peninsula Day & Wine Tasting in Constantia

Time: 8h15AM Western Cape

09:00 travel along the Atlantic Seaboard through Sea Point, Clifton and Camp's Bay continuing along Chapman's Peak Drive, voted the most scenic coastal drive in the world, through Noordhoek and Kommetjie round the southern end of the peninsula to Simonstown for lunch followed with a visit to the endangered African Penguin colony at Boulders Beach. This is followed by lunch in Simonstown. The tour then continues along False Bay towards the city stopping en route at Groot Constantia, the oldest wine farm in South Africa, for a cellar tour and wine tasting. Late afternoon the tour enters the Bokaap (Cape Malay Quarters with brightly coloured houses) to learn the history of this unique national heritage site. End at the Bokaap Kombuis restaurant, with beautiful views of the city lights, for a buffet supper to taste the local Cape Malay cuisine.

<u>Included:</u> transport, tourist guide, breakfast, seal island boat cruise, Boulders Beach entrance tickets, 2 course or a seafood platter for lunch at Black Marlin restaurant, Groot Constantia cellar tour and wine tasting, buffet supper at Bokaap Kombuis restaurant, accommodation at a 4 star hotel, 2 x 500ml water pp.

Day #7: Tour of the Overberg

Time: 9h00AM Western Cape

Depart after breakfast for a tour of the Overberg region (over the mountain) known for its sea food, fishing communities, abalone, whale watching, penguins and sharks. Your day can include an abalone farm tour and tasting in Hermanus. Abalone is a highly sort after delicacy and this is one of a few legalized abalone farms in South Africa. South African abalone is rated the second-best abalone in the world. This is followed by a whale watching boat cruise from Hermanus harbour to sight the Southern Right and Humped Backed whales that calf in the bay from June to November each year. Alternatives to whale cruise: shark cage diving or a marine eco safari at Gansbaai, known as the shark capital of South Africa. Return to Cape Town late afternoon.
